As you can see, our expected income has not met the church's expenses. Our expenses have been inline with the budget; however, our contributions have been significantly lower than we budgeted. Certainly, cost of service for building operation has been increased especially with bills like fuel cost. We have refrained from any big repair projects that we initially had planned as part of this year's budget. That explains why are expenses have improved.

This last month we had to borrow \$50,000 from our Line of Credit at the bank to cover our expenses. This will be a bill which needs to be paid back (current interest rate is 6%). Please pray for our church and our finances. May God bless everything we are doing here at Emanuel which we do in His name.

## Stewardship Newsletter Reading for September 2022

SEEK ME.....NO HIDING!!

When the childhood game of hide-and-seek is played correctly, there is one "seeker" and several "hidiers", who attempt to find obscure hiding places and avoid being found by the "seeker". Obviously, the hidiers don't tell the seeker where they may be found; this would defeat the object of the game. But Jesus plays in a different way.

God promises in Proverbs 8:17, "Those who seek Me diligently find Me." To clarify, the verse doesn't continue with qualifiers such as "you may find Me" or "sometimes you'll find Me or even "if you've been good, you'll find Me." God is emphatic here: You will find Me.

In the game above, Jesus represents the all-time and ultimate seeker - He never stops seeking us. Whether it's the lost coin, the lost sheep, or the lost us, He's shown that when something is lost, the search begins, and when the lost is found, rejoicing ensues.

And it is only because Jesus seeks and finds us that we can, in turn, find Him. And where do we find Him? in the very places He has told us He can be found: in His Word and Sacraments. He won't forsake us when we seek Him, He will be there.
