## Pastor's Post

### Being Hearers and then Doers of the Word

Being new to Emanuel, I can't tell you how tickled I was to see the banner hanging in the social hall that reads "Be Ye Doers". As the banner reminds us, this phrase is based on James 1:22. But what does "Be Ye Doers" really mean? To understand what God is telling us here we must look at the whole verse. From the English Standard Version we read, "But be doers of the Word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves." To get the fuller context we see that verse 21 talks about receiving the implanted Word which saves our souls, and verses 23-24 compare a man who only hears the Word but doesn't do the Word to a man who glances at a mirror and soon forgets what he looks like. Here our Lord is reminding us that hearing comes first, and then doing will follow. In order to be doers of the Word, we must first truly be hearers. Otherwise, our doing becomes divorced from the Gospel and the salvation Jesus won for us on the cross.

Being doers without first truly hearing and listening is forgetting the essence of what the Word is and does. In the beginning, the Word spoke everything into existence (Genesis 1). That Word was and is Jesus Christ (John 1:1-3). Jesus – the Word made flesh (John 1:14) – spoke and Lazarus came out of the grave (John 11:43-44). Jesus calmed the storm with His Word (Mark 4:39). Jesus drove out demons with His Word (Luke 4:35). He healed lepers with His Word (Luke 17:14). We are told in Scripture that faith – brought by the Holy Spirit – comes from hearing the Word of Christ (Romans 10:17, 1 Corinthians 12:3). The Word literally makes us wise unto salvation because it is God-breathed (2 Timothy 3:15-17). The Word is the engine that makes our faith go.

Following in the footsteps of the Sermon on the Mount, James – the brother of our Lord – reminds all baptized children of God that all who first hear – truly listening to the Word – and then do will be like a wise man who builds his house on the rock (Matthew 7:24). That house built on Jesus' Word will withstand everything and be a shining light to the world. Those who don't truly hear, and therefore don't really do His Word are like a man who build his house on shifting sand. That house won't last, and in the end, it won't do anyone any good.

My family and I are so blessed to be here to serve Emanuel and to grow with all of you in the hearing and then doing of Christ's Word. In order to be hearers first and then doers, we will have plenty of Bible study opportunities. Sunday mornings after worship we will study the Word together. Wednesday evenings we will be starting a book reading group. Thursdays at 1 pm, we will be having a LifeLight study where we look at individual books of the Bible. Also, the Ladies of Emanuel have a monthly study, and we are hoping to start a men's group again. In addition to worship and your daily devotions, please consider joining us for one of the many opportunities to hear and learn God's Word together in Bible study. When we are hearers, then the Holy Spirit will make us doers of the Word. A blessed and Happy New Year to all!
